

**RESOLUTIONS
OF THE BIG SPRING INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, the Big Spring Independent School District (“District”) and City of Big Spring (“City”) are each political subdivisions of the State of Texas;

WHEREAS, the City of Big Spring intends to hold a regular election on May 3, 2025;

WHEREAS, the Big Spring Independent School District’s Board of Trustees intends for the District to hold a general trustee election on May 3, 2025;

WHEREAS, Texas Election Code § 271.002(a) authorizes the governing bodies of political subdivisions to enter into an agreement to hold joint elections in election precincts that can be served by common polling places;

WHEREAS, the governing bodies of the District and the City desire to hold a joint election as set forth in the Joint Election Agreement (“Agreement”), attached as Exhibit “A” and fully incorporated as if set forth herein;

WHEREAS, the District intends to enter an Election Services Agreement, attached as Exhibit “B,” with Howard County, as permitted by Texas Election Code Chapter 31, which shall govern the conduct of the election, except as set forth in the Joint Election Agreement;

WHEREAS, the City and the District serve electors within the same boundary, and it would be to the benefit of the City, the District, and the citizens and voters thereof, to hold the elections jointly in the election precincts that can be served by common polling places insofar as possible.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of the Big Spring Independent School District hereby adopts the above recitals as findings of fact and operative provisions hereof the same as if set out in full;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the election shall be held jointly with City of Big Spring as permitted under Texas Election Code §271.002 and required by Texas Education Code §11.0581; and

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the Board authorizes the Board President to enter into the attached Joint Election Agreement and Election Services Agreement.
