District plan to make up time or days for inclement weather

In a recent Commissioner's Memo released by the Arkansas Department of Education the state provided guidance regarding options for Districts to make up instructional time missed due to inclement weather. Districts currently on a traditional 178-day calendar may request to change to an alternate calendar, which requires 1,068 hours, the equivalent of 6 hours of instructional time for 178 days (6 hours per day x 178 days = 1068 hours of instruction).

It is important to note that 6 hours of instruction time each day is the minimum standard. Currently our Elementary School provides a minimum of 6 hours and 12 minutes of instruction in the daily schedule. These additional 12 minutes per day over the course of 175 school days banks a total of 2.100 minutes or 5.8 days. This is more than enough to make up for the 3 days missed due to inclement weather.

The High School provides 6 hours of instruction each day. Therefore, the three missed days will be made up as follows:

One day will be made up by having school in session on Presidents Day, February 19th. Two days (720 minutes) will be made up by doing away with home room (8minutes per day) and adding 4 minutes to the current daily schedule at the beginning and/or end of the day. This will add 12 minutes per day times 63 days of school which equals 756 minutes. This equates to two days and 36 minutes.

As a result of inclement weather/road conditions the District was closed on January 16-18 (3 days). If the District transitions to an alternate calendar students will NOT be required to make up bad weather days as a result of banked instructional time. If no more days are missed during the remaining school year, the last day of school remains May 23, 2024.

Note: The Arkansas Department of Education issued a waiver that allows Districts to transition their calendar from traditional to alternate. Alternate calendars require 1,068 hours. Through the waiver process Districts have been allowed to "bank" instructional time and substitute that time for inclement weather days. The Marmaduke School District will adjust our daily schedule to exceed the minimum standard of 6 hours of instruction each day and will take advantage of the waiver process. Transitioning to an alternate calendar ensures students will NOT be required to make up 2 of the inclement weather days.
