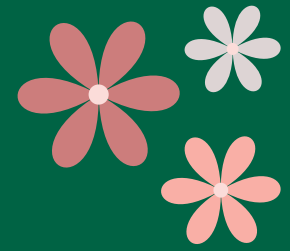


April
