- ❖ Taking many classes including AP classes made it very difficult to spend time with family
- This day off will reduce stressing about school and missing work on many muslim students including myself
- ❖ It's a three day holiday- Over the years it's become harder to celebrate all 3days because most don't want to miss school for that long so now it's become a norm to only take one day off
- ❖ If we do get the day off we will set an example to all schools in all of Oregon
- ❖ All my muslim friends were complaining about having school on Eid it's a conversation we have every year as a group this year we decided to take a step forward
- Other students stress even after taking the day off because they know how much work is waiting for them
- ❖ I bought this idea forward april of last school year, but since it was on short notice I didn't expect that it was going to happen but this year I am only a junior and have 2 years ahead of me and I hope to achieve this not just for those in highschool this year but for the incoming muslim students in our school district.
- ❖ This will improves Diversity and make the muslim students all the more included
- My little sister is an incoming freshman and I would love for her not to have to make the difficult decision between school and family.
- Some years Eid falls on a weekend so this won't be a problem every year only on weekdays we ask for a day off
- Every year the date moves so if it's a worry about AP exams just know that it will continue moving away from the time of Exams. It moves about 11 days every year, for example last year it was may 2nd but this year it will be april 21st or the 22nd
- ❖ We want to be great students but also have a great relationship with our families and be there for fun memories
