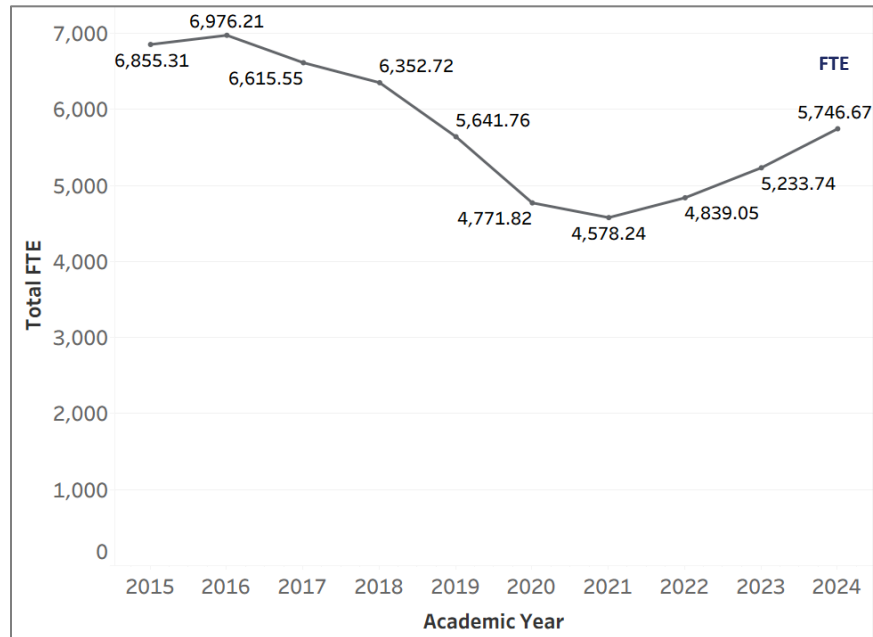


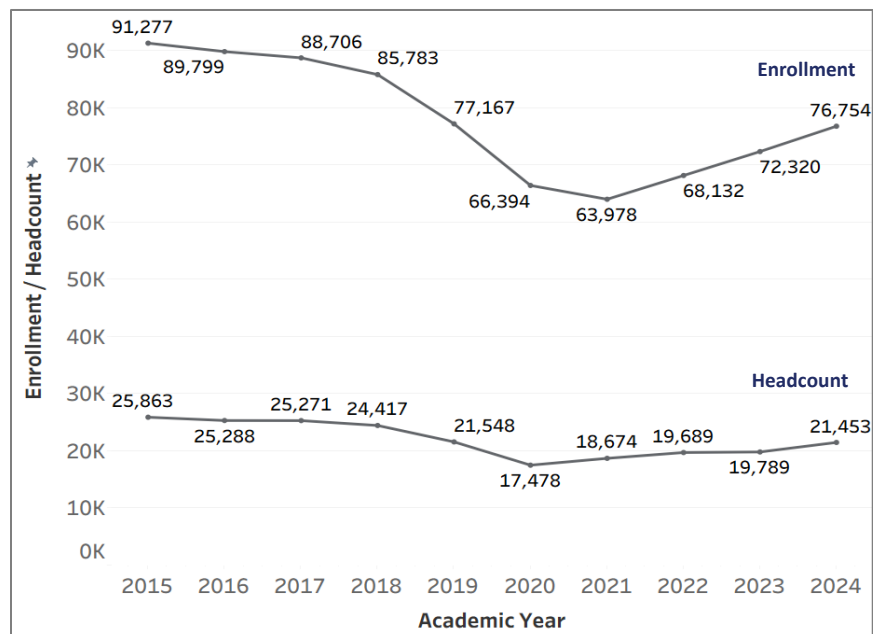
## Full Time Equivalent (FTE)

In 2024-2025, CCC generated 5,746.67 total FTE, 99% of which was reimbursable. FTE was up 9.8% from the previous year.



## Headcount and Enrollment

In 2024-2025, CCC served 21,453 unique students (headcount), which was an increase of 8.4% from the previous year. Course enrollments were up 6.1% from the previous year.



### FTE by Course Offering

FTE continues to increase in nearly all areas after the onset of the pandemic in Academic Year 2019-2020.

### Credit and Non-Credit Students

The proportion of students who were enrolled in credit courses decreased slightly. In Fall 2023, 65% of students were enrolled in credit courses while in Fall 2024, 63% of students were enrolled in credit courses.

### Enrollment Status for Credit Students

There was a one percent increase in full-time students. Of credit-seeking students, 26% were enrolled full-time while 74% were enrolled part-time in Fall Term 2024. Among part-time students, there was an increase in half-time students (28% in Fall 2023 | 30% in Fall 2024) and a decrease in less than half-time students (46% in Fall 2023 | 44% in Fall 2024). Half-time students are enrolled in 6-11 credits and less than half-time students are enrolled in 1-5 credits.

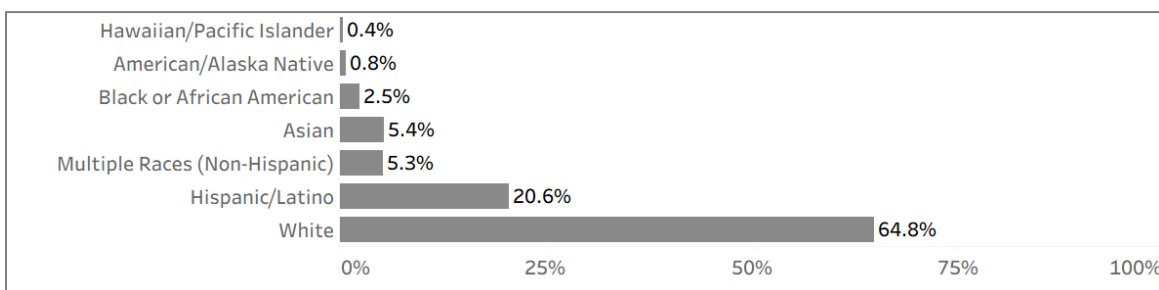

#### Legal Sex

CCC did not see a change in the proportion of students by Legal Sex. About 52% of students were Female, 48% were Male, and <1% were Non-binary.

#### Race & Ethnicity

Over time, the percentage of students who are Students of Color has been increasing. In 2024-2025, 35% of students were Students of Color. This increase is largely due to increases in Hispanic/Latino students.

### Awards History

The number of awards earned is increasing for most types of awards. In Academic Year 2024-2025, 1,179 students completed a total of 1,450 awards.

### Time to Completion

In 2024-2025, 23.7% of students completed their award within 100% of the time to degree (e.g., two years for a two-year degree). Another 19.3% completed their award with 150% of time, and an additional 15.4% of students completed within 200% of time. The final 41.6% took over 200% of time to complete their degree. As compared to 2023-2024, students who completed an award in 2024-2025 completed their awards slightly more quickly.
