Teaching Learning & Relevance

- The fall assessment window has concluded. The administration met with all grade-level teams to review and analyze the data and begin planning the next steps regarding WIN groups. Although this is a continuous process, initial groupings are slated to start in the next week.
- Structured Literacy Oral Language Training took place on September 30th for all K 2 staff. This training reviewed oral language and the importance of having clear routines to address oral language development. Work will continue throughout this school year to increase the intentional implementation of oral language development.

- The Hatchet Pride (PBIS) weekly student nominations for those students who have displayed characteristics of being role models started at the beginning of September.
- All elementary staff concluded their Love and Logic training. As a reminder, Love and Logic is a research-based teaching approach that helps create positive, calm, and effective classrooms by building relationships and teaching problem-solving skills. The Hatchet Pride Committee will work on streamlining Love and Logic with our daily work with students. Planning to support continued learning for staff has also begun.
