RE: Fieldhouse and CTE Door Access Control

This proposal outlines a coordinated expansion of the Honeywell Win-Pak access control system for Minooka Community High School District #111 to support upcoming facility additions. The first quote of this expansion targets the Central Campus CTE Addition and remodel for a total cost of \$23,595.00. This portion of the project includes the installation of three Honeywell MPA4 4-door control panels, nine switchplate-profile credential readers, and necessary cabling. While the initial quote for the Central campus excluded certain infrastructure, it is now confirmed that all necessary cabling for these door locations is included in the project scope.

The second phase addresses the Minooka South Fieldhouse Addition and Remodel at a cost of \$23,145.00. This project provides access control for five specific locations and includes two Honeywell MPA4 control panels, five credential readers, and necessary cabling. Similar to the Central campus project, this phase includes all required cabling, installation, programming, and testing to ensure the fieldhouse is fully integrated into the district's security network. By standardizing equipment across both campuses, the district ensures consistent security management and simplified administrative oversight.

The total combined investment for these safety and security enhancements is \$46,740.00. This project aligns with the current setup at both campuses and would extend our security and access to both building additions.
