Summary:	Career and Technical Education in Cedar Hill ISD provides students with opportunities to explore career pathways, earn industry-recognized certifications, and prepare for postsecondary success. This update aligns with the Texas State Vision for CTE and district priorities for college, career, and military readiness.

The update will provide an overview of the state vision and strategic priorities for CTE, along with a review of funding sources, including Perkins V and PIC 22. It will highlight CHISD's programs of study across multiple career clusters, current and three-year enrollment trends, course sequences, and opportunities for students to earn industry-based certifications that directly connect to state accountability through CCMR. Key accountability elements such as PEIMS autocoding, summer submissions, and the definition of CTE student categories will also be addressed. Program highlights include the Longhorn Level Up transition initiative, expansion of work-based learning experiences, and the district's engagement in the STEM ecosystem. The presentation will conclude with a look at the future of CTE in CHISD, focusing on expanded pathways, stronger workforce alignment, and sustainable partnerships.
