Texas Virtual Academy at Hallsville

Elementary & Middle School

As the TVAH 3-8 campus sprang back to life on Monday, we find ourselves super excited and looking forward to what the 25-26 school year has in store for our students and families. Our teachers came back from summer break full of enthusiasm and incredibly excited to welcome our Bobcats back next week. Our time spent together this week has been focused on how we can improve student outcomes, enhance engagement in the virtual classroom, and leverage our data to drive instructional strategies.

Professional Development Highlights:

STAAR Data Analysis:

A major focus for us this week was analyzing our STAAR data from the 24-25 spring testing season. Our teams worked closely to not only review and reflect upon our overall results, but also looked at the top five highly missed questions and analyzed the student responses for those. Then they reflected on past instructional strategies and how they might tackle those TEKS differently in the 25-26 school year. In dissecting the past performance of our students, we have developed strategies to address learning gaps and support students in meeting grade level expectations.

Teach Big:

The ES and MS staff had the pleasure of getting to work with Randi Whitney from Teach Big on Friday. During their time together, teachers were invited to open their eyes to a new and fresh way of looking at and studying TEKS. Randi helped equip our teachers with tools and strategies needed to effectively implement TEKS every day. She acknowledged and validated the challenges and struggles that teachers face in implementing TEKS effectively and then gave our teachers a plethora of tools to help our teachers better understand how to align their instructional practices to fully and effectively teach TEKS to mastery for our students.

Accountability:

Earlier in the week, our teams had the pleasure of meeting with our data specialist, Jessica Jacobo, who took them on a deep dive of school accountability. Our team walked away brainstorming ideas for how they can directly impact our overall school accountability. We are excited to see the outcomes of these strategies as the year progresses.

Looking Ahead:

As we prepare to embark on the 25-26 school year, we are filled with excitement for the new opportunities this year will bring. We are confident that keeping our students at the center of everything we do will yield the positive outcomes we're seeking. We will continue to focus on data driven instruction and ensuring that both our students and teachers have the tools they need to succeed in the 25-26 school year.

We have significantly expanded our social media outreach to keep families informed and engaged. Title 1

The Curriculum Coordinators are working on finalizing courses for the first day of school. We have developed a process for copying courses, so teachers are working from the same tier 1 course



and have collaborated with the Instructional Special Programs team for modifications and accommodations. We are on track to finalize courses by 8:00 AM on 8/11 to initiate the course cloning process. We are currently developing our specific data analysis and course feedback/review process so we can have a process for long term adjustments and "fire drill" adjustments (if we find an urgent change that needs to be implemented in courses). These will be finalized for implementation in September. We are working closely with all teams on documenting course changes to support us as we track and analyze the efficacy of each course and the impact any changes/adjustments have on student achievement and engagement.

Instructional Specialists are planning support classes for our DAEP students and are working on resources to present to families in partnership with our ambassadors for monthly Town Halls.

The Engagement and Attendance teams are gearing up, training families and sharing the best tips and tricks for success! We are excited about our 2025-26 school year!

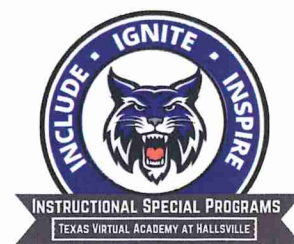
Our campus behavior team continues to welcome students to our DAEP campus! We are working diligently to review student needs and provide behavior guidance for students, staff, and families.
