## Alaska Developmental Profile (ADP)

• The purpose of the ADP is to identify, record, and summarize the skills and behaviors students demonstrate upon entry to school, based on teacher observations.

- Student skills and behaviors are defined by whether students are consistently demonstrating 13-goals and indicators in the following five (5) domains from Alaska's Early Learning Guidelines:
  - o Physical Well-Being, Health, and Motor Development
  - Social and Emotional Development
  - Approaches to Learning
  - Cognition and General Knowledge
  - Communication, Language, and Literacy
- Once again, thank you to Mr. Tobias Frieb, our Kindergarten Teacher, and Mrs. Cindy Glore, our Title I Teacher & District Testing Coordinator, for ensuring the CES is in compliance with the ADP requirement.

# **CMS Quarterly Electives**

- As CMS elective classes are quarter based, the start of Quarter 2 brought our middle school students choices for their new elective classes.
- First hour elective offerings include: Math Lab, Computer Science/iDidaclass, Yearbook, Basketball Fundamentals, & SEALS, Band, Study Hall. Whereas, seventh hour elective offerings include: Lit Corner, Uke Me, Science Tech II, Keyboarding, & SEALS.
- The CMS staff works diligently to provide students with the electives of their choice. However, due certain classes needing to be capped given the specific nature of that particular class, at times the chosen elective may be "full," in which case students receive their alternative choice. In the CMS, we register students for their electives in the 8<sup>th</sup> grade first, then move to 7<sup>th</sup> grade, and then onto 6<sup>th</sup> grade last.

- Alaska State Law, Sec. 14.30.127, states:
  - "A vision and hearing screening examination shall be given to each child attending school in the state. The examinations shall be made when the child enters school or as soon thereafter as is practicable, and at regular intervals specified by regulation by the governing body of the district."
- The CEMS has scheduled Vision & Hearing Screenings for Wednesday, November 10<sup>th</sup>. Given Vision & Hearing Screenings were canceled last year due to the COVID Pandemic, all students in all grade levels K-8<sup>th</sup>, will be screened unless their parent/guardian specifies otherwise. Referral letters will be mailed home as designated by the screening results.
