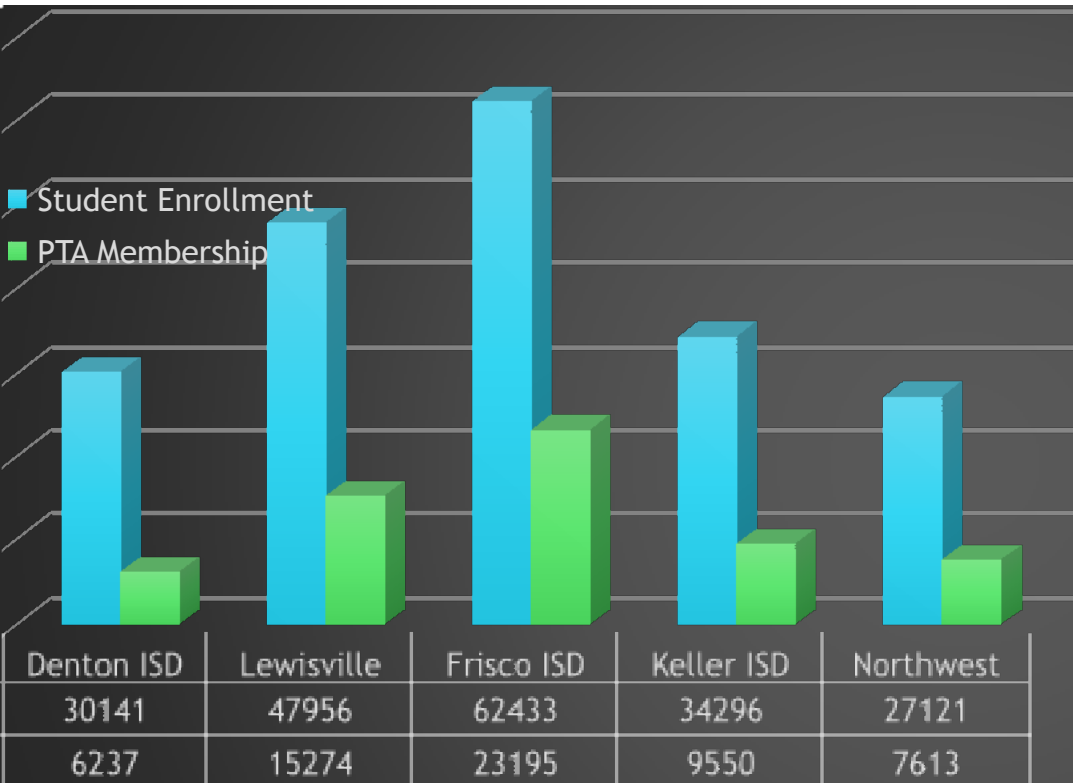

All that really matters is what lives WITHIN!

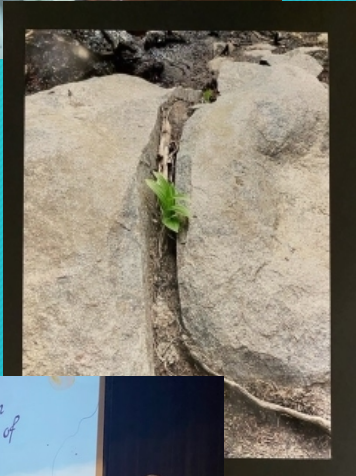
