Letterman Jackets

Last year, the total cost for jackets was **\$8,210**, and the year before it was **\$8,715**. The district pays a cost of **\$25 per jacket**, which is a modest expense when compared to the overall value it brings to the students.

- **UIL Award Limit**: The UIL award dollar limit per student is **\$75**, which we are well under. This opportunity to provide letterman jackets as part of the recognition for our student athletes hard work and commitment offers a ROI is not measurable.
- **Parent-Paid Jackets**: If we are unable to fund these jackets through the district budget, our parents would be required to cover the cost. However, after researching outside vendors, the price for letterman jackets varies:
 - Vendor 1 (SSR): \$159 per jacket
 - o Vendor 2 (A1 Sports): \$265.99 per jacket
 - Vendor 3 (Varsity Made): \$255.95 per jacket
