Background Information: The Academic Excellence Indicator System (AEIS) pulls together a wide range of information on the performance of students in each school and district in Texas every year. The performance indicators for 2011-12 are:

- 1. Results of the Texas Assessment of Knowledge and Skills (TAKS*), note: for 2011-12, TAKS is only available for grades 10 and 11.
- 2. Exit-level TAKS Cumulative Passing Rates
- 3. Progress of Prior Year TAKS Failures
- 4. Attendance Rates
- 5. Annual Dropout Rates (grades 7-8 and grades 9-12)
- 6. Completion Rates (4-year and 5-year longitudinal)
- 7. College Readiness Indicators
 - Completion of Advanced/Dual Enrollment Courses
 - Completion of the Recommended High School Program or Distinguished Achievement Program
 - Participation and Performance on Advanced Placement (AP) and International Baccalaureate (IB) Examinations
 - Texas Success Initiative (TSI) Higher Education Readiness Component
 - Participation and Performance on the College Admissions Tests (SAT and ACT)
 - College-Ready Graduates

Performance on each of these indicators is shown disaggregated by ethnicity, special education, low income status, limited English proficient status, and at risk. The reports also provide extensive information on school and district staff, finances, programs, and student demographics.
