1. <u>Board Goal:</u> DOMAIN 4: Alignment of financial well being with student achievement:

2. Background:

Uvalde Consolidated Independent School District (UCISD) intends to apply for 2025–2026 federal entitlement grants under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) as amended by the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA), Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA B), and the Strengthening Career and Technical Education for the 21st Century Act (Perkins V). These federal programs support key educational services and strategic initiatives aligned with the district's academic and operational goals.

3. Process:

The district conducts an annual review of student demographics, instructional needs, and compliance requirements to develop and submit federal grant applications. Stakeholder feedback is solicited through public notification and district planning committees. Final grant applications are due to the Texas Education Agency (TEA) by June 30, 2025. Public comments or questions regarding the 2025–2026 ESSA grant application will be accepted through Monday, June 9, 2025.

4. Fiscal Impact:

The district anticipates applying for the following estimated entitlements, based on a projected 10% decrease from 2024–2025 funding levels:

- **Title I, Part A**: \$1,939,391 Supplemental support for schools with high concentrations of low-income students.
- Title II, Part A: \$232,179 Professional development for educators and school leaders.
- Title III, Part A: \$28,223 Support for English language learners.
- **Title III, Part A Immigrant**: \$99,570 Region 20 is paid this amount for a contract for immigrant/migrant student support.
- **Title IV, Part A**: \$154,071 Well-rounded education, improve school conditions for student learning and improve the use of technology.
- **IDEA B (Special Education)**: \$872,906 (Formula); \$200 (Preschool); \$193,195 (Deaf Education).
- Perkins V (CTE): \$77,951 Career and technical education program development.
