Claims;

- Reimbursement figures for the month of May are as follows: The total amount is \$177,903.27 compared to \$178,081.18 for 2016. Our reimbursement was down by \$177.90 compared to 2016. We had the same number of serving days at 19 for both years. The difference in the reimbursement was because our numbers were down for breakfast this year.
- The breakfast numbers for 2017 are 41,030 and for 2016 was 43,175 so we were down in our breakfast numbers by 1,872.
- The lunch numbers for 2017 are 46,609 and for 2016 are 46,445 for a difference of 164 more for 2017.
- We wanted to let you know that this year we only had \$44.00 dollars of uncollected meal charges. We had four schools that still had charges that we were not able to collect. We had a zero balance at Minico this year and that was a great accomplishment. Our kitchen managers and staff worked really hard to get these collected this year.
