<u>Class Changes</u>	The campus principal shall be authorized to investigate and ap- prove the transfer of a student from one classroom to another on that campus.			
<u>Transfers Between</u> <u>Schools</u>	The Superintendent shall be authorized to investigate and approve transfers between schools.			
Transfers Between Classes and Campuses	Except as provided in this policy and regulations hereunder, a stu- dent shall be assigned to a school that serves the attendance zone in which his or her responsible parents, guardian, or other person having lawful custody or control resides. The Superintendent or de- signee and campus principals shall be authorized to investigate and approve transfers of a student from one classroom to another or between campuses, as appropriate for the educational environ- ment. A student who wishes to attend a school other than as as- signed shall obtain prior approval from the office of student ser- vices or the Superintendent's designee under the following guidelines.			
Factors to Consider	The transfer of a student from one attendance zone to another shall be approved or disapproved based on the following consider- ations, or other lawful basis, in accordance with applicable proce- dures. [See FDB(REGULATION)]			
Principles of Zoning	Neighborhood school attendance zones are intended to optimize efficient use of available facilities and to maintain relatively bal- anced enrollments of diverse populations. The principles ex- pressed in FC(LOCAL) regarding changes to attendances zones shall apply to transfers as well.			
Employees' Children	Children or dependents of full-time employees may attend school within the zone of the employees' home campus worksite, if de- sired.			
Capacities	Enrollment capacities and educationally appropriate class size caps shall be observed.			
Curriculum Transfers	A student may transfer from the school in his or her attendance zone in order to take any course that is not offered in his or her at- tendance zone, provided crowded conditions do not exist.			
Other Accommodations	Transfers to accommodate child-care needs for working parents, attendance of siblings in the same school, continuity for former stu- dents, or untimely change of residence shall be approved only
