Purchase New Backhoe

Background Information

The district's existing backhoe is approximately 29 years old, has exceeded its expected service life, and has become increasingly unreliable and costly to maintain. Replacing this equipment is necessary to ensure continued operational efficiency, minimize downtime, and support timely response to maintenance needs across district facilities.

The district proposes the purchase of a new 2024 New Holland B75D loader backhoe through an approved Sourcewell cooperative purchasing contract, which provides competitively bid pricing and ensures compliance with procurement requirements. As part of this purchase, the district will trade in the existing backhoe for \$10,500, reducing the overall cost. The cooperative pricing reflects a significant discount from list price, and the final purchase amount, including delivery and related charges and after trade-in, totals \$74,658.20 as detailed in the attached quote.
