#5030 1 2 **Assignment of Students to School** 3 The Madison Board of Education (the "Board") shall identify attendance areas within the 4 5 Town of Madison and assign schools within the jurisdiction of the Board to serve the 6 students residing in such attendance areas. Students will be required to attend school in 7 the attendance area in which they reside, unless special permission has been granted by 8 the Superintendent or unless attendance at a school outside of the attendance area is 9 required by law. The Madison Public Schools (the "District") reserves the right to assign 10 students to schools outside their normalassigned attendance area as appropriate to create 11 and / or maintain equitable class sizes for grades one through four. Final placement of 12 students in the elementary schools will be determined on the basis of both current and 13 projected student enrollment for each of the attendance areas. 14 15 Attendance at a school outside of the student's attendance area is permitted if required by 16 law, including but not limited to the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act, based on a student's disability. The District will 17 18 follow all applicable legal procedures to determine if such placement is required and, if 19 required, to implement such placement. 20 21 Special permission for a student to attend a school outside the student's attendance area 22 may be granted by the Superintendent if: 23 24 25 26 The change involves an identified special needs student or a hardship case, or 27 if there are medical considerations: 28 29 • The change appears to be is in the best interests of the student or of the school, 30 in the sole discretion of the Superintendent; 31 32 The legal residence of a student changes from one attendance area to another 33 within the Town of Madison district during the school year and the 34 parentsparent(s)/guardian(s) wish the student to remain in his or her the
