Agenda Item: Connects Consortium Update

Background Information: Connects Learning Center is a program that our district has participated in since 2001. Over 1000 students have graduated with a high school diploma largely because of the opportunities offered through Connects. The consortium consists of Cudahy, South Milwaukee, Franklin, and Oak Creek. The participating four school districts allocate funds to assure that they have 18 seats for their most struggling students. The population of students served at Connects over the past 19 years typically are plagued with a mental health diagnosis, homelessness, along with being credit deficient. This past year turned out to be Connects' most successful school year yet. Cudahy doubled their graduating students from last year to this year. Connects is helping some of our most struggling students to successfully complete high school and to explore post secondary options.
