What's new in Elementary Youth Enrichment?

Each meeting, young athletes practice elementary skills with drills, skill-based games and playing unique adaptations of the sport they are focused on during class. For instance, a unique adaptation for basketball may be no dribbling during the game, only passing. This helps to develop ball movement, court spacing and teamwork.

Junior Soccer
