Personal Communication Devices	A student shall not use a personal communication device on school property during the school day. While on school property, the stu- dent shall store any personal communication device in accordance with administrative regulations.	
	A student who violates this policy or any regulations shall be sub- ject to discipline in accordance with the Board-adopted Student Code of Conduct.	
	An authorized District employee shall confiscate a student's per- sonal communication device that is used in violation of this policy or any applicable regulations.	
	If a personal communication device is not retrieved, the District shall dispose of the device after providing the notice required by law.	
Exceptions	A student shall be authorized to use a personal communication de- vice on school property during the school day only under the fol- lowing circumstances:	
	den	student's use is necessary for implementation of the stu- t's individualized education program, a 504 plan, or a simi- program or plan;
		student's use is required due to a documented need ed on a directive from a qualified physician; or
	safe	student's use is necessary to comply with a health or ety requirement imposed by law or as part of the District or pus safety protocols.
Implementation	The Superintendent shall develop regulations to implement this policy.	
Compliance	Annually, the Superintendent shall report to the Board on the imple- mentation and compliance of this policy.
