Issue Summary:

North Slope Borough School District held its annual competition of the Battle of the Books on Thursday, January 27th.

Over 125 students and 8 schools participated in this Slope wide reading program.

Time spent reading is the number one research activity proven to improve students reading ability. Student's with the support of their coaches and families spent many hours reading, or in the early grades having books read to them.

This monumental event includes students reading 12 to 15 books between September and January. Students also must keep track of characters, events, and setting of books. These student leaders model fortitude and determination as they prepare and participate in Battle of the Books competition.
