  - 9. Action Items
  - 10. Information/Discussion Items
  - 11. Reports
  - 12. Authorizer Update
  - 13. Next Meeting's Preparation
  - 14. Board Meeting Evaluation
  - 15. Adjournment
- B. CCS's school board may depart from the order of business with the consent of the majority of directors present.
