SUMMARY:

This item requests approval for the purchase of personal protective equipment (PPE) in the amount of \$1,000,000.00.

BOARD GOAL:

Growth & Management - demonstrate effective and efficient management of district resources

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

To provide for the health and safety of the Districts staff & students; it is anticipated that future purchases of personal protective equipment (PPE) may be necessary over the coming weeks and months. Types of PPE that may be considered are hand sanitizer, surface disinfecting wipes and desk shields. This is not an inclusive list as additional items may be recognized as current inventory supplies are utilized and future needs are identified.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

Purchases will be made in compliance with Denton ISD Board Policies CH (Local) and CH (Legal). Purchases may be made from the Approved Vendor List, or any other vendor who meets the requirements of CH (Legal) in order to obtain the best value for the District. This purchase is being brought for approval in accordance with the District's CH (local) policy.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

Cost will be borne by the General Fund – Fund Balance.

BENEFIT OF ACTION:

Passage will allow the District to purchase additional personal protective equipment (PPE) up to \$1,000,000,00 to be ready for the 2020-2021 school year.
