**Update: New Grading and Assessment Practices**

#### Purpose of Report

For the past two years, the secondary Academic Leadership Team (ALT) and the Secondary Curriculum, Instruction, and Staff Development Department have been examining our grading practices in an effort to make sure our practices support our beliefs about learning, assessment, and grading. The result of that work has been the implementation and phase in of new grading guidelines and procedures beginning with the 2014-2015 school year.

During this year, our district staff has worked to implement these new procedures with great care and an emphasis on student success. We have reflected on and refined our work by collaboratively addressing the challenges and celebrating the successes that are part of our professional practice. Feedback has been gathered from teachers, principals, parents, students and district administrators. The purpose of this report is to provide an update and the feedback that has been gathered and to outline next steps that we believe will best support our teachers' and students' efforts.
