HOUSE BILL 5 (HB5)

- Created Community and Student Engagement Accountability Rating (TEC 39.0545 – Section 46 of HB 5)

WHAT IS TEC 39.0545?

Texas Education Code 39.0545

- Requires each district to evaluate the district's performance and the performance of each campus in the district on community and student engagement (8 factors) and in policy compliance (1 factor)
- Requires every district to assign itself and each campus a rating of exemplary, recognized, acceptable or unacceptable for both overall performance and each evaluation factor
- Districts must submit ratings to TEA and make publicly available August 8th of each school year.

NINE FACTORS TO BE EVALUATED

- Fine arts
- Wellness and physical education
- Community and parent involvement
- 21st Workforce development program
- 2nd language acquisition
- Digital language acquisition program
- Dropout prevention strategies
- Educational programs for GT students
- Compliance with statutory reporting and policy requirements

5 PHASE FRAMEWORK TO DEVELOP CRITERIA

- Phase 1: Laying the Foundation
- Phase 2: Preparing for the Gathering of Information/Input
- Phase 3: Rubrics will be finalized and shared with campuses through Share Point site by the end of this month
- Phase 4: Rating Process- district and campus will rate themselves & upload documentation of rating by 2nd week in May
- Phase 5: Final Ratings will be reviewed by district and presented to School Board.
 - Our ratings will be made public by August 8, 2014.
