Teaching and Learning

- **Explicit Instruction**
- We will be continuing our work with this year with Explicit Instruction. Our planning meeting with our building leadership team and April Schofield from CESA 9 is the afternoon of August 8th so I will provide more information at the board meeting.
- **Literacy Leadership Institute**
- On June 13&14 we had a small group (Mark Schommer, Thersea Burzynski, Angie McPherson, Aubrey Boisvert, Tara Messer) attend a Cesa 9 Literacy in Leadership Institute. We worked on viewing our current practices and developing goals to help us further our work to develop a Literacy Leadership team for TES. The main goal of the Literacy Leadership Team for TES will be to develop a system of instruction that matches our Literacy Team's Mission and Vision of Literacy. We will have meetings throughout this school year, so I will keep you informed of our progress. I think that it is also important to note that this work isn't going to stand alone.
