Item Title: Approve to Submit Application for the Optional Flexible School Day for the 2020-2021 school year

Description: The Optional Flexible School Day is approved for a period of one (1) school year. The program aims to improve the graduation rates for students who are in danger of dropping out of school, have dropped out, or who are behind in core subjects. The program also provides flexible scheduling for our at-risk students. Seventy-five students entered the program this year--41 have graduated so far with 14 of them being fifth year seniors.

Historical Data: The Board approved this same agreement last year on July 24th, 2019.
