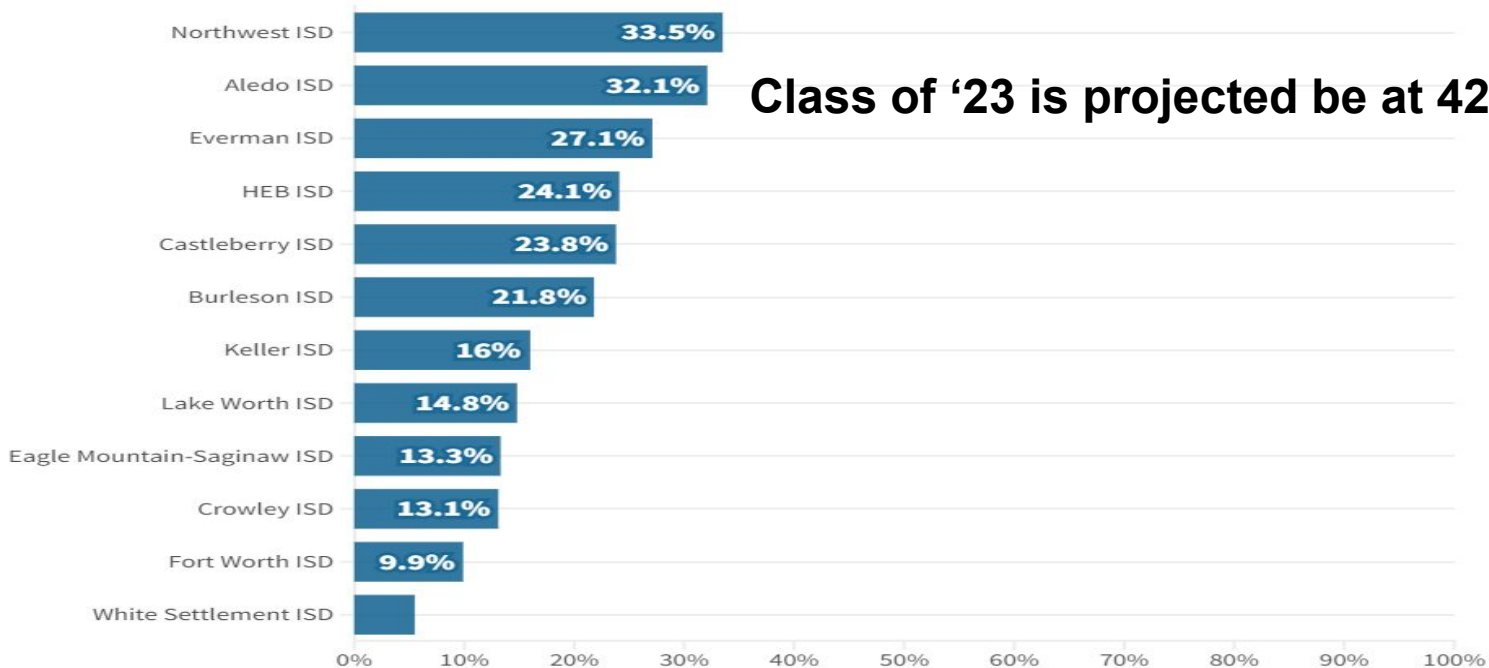


Currently, 2,688 of 3,538 students are taking a CTE course! That's 76%!

Which school districts in Fort Worth have the most graduates with an industry-level certification?

Six of Fort Worth's 12 school districts each saw at least 20% of their 2021 graduates earn an industry-level certification. **The highest percentage was in Northwest ISD, where more than one in three graduates walked the stage with an industry-level certification.**

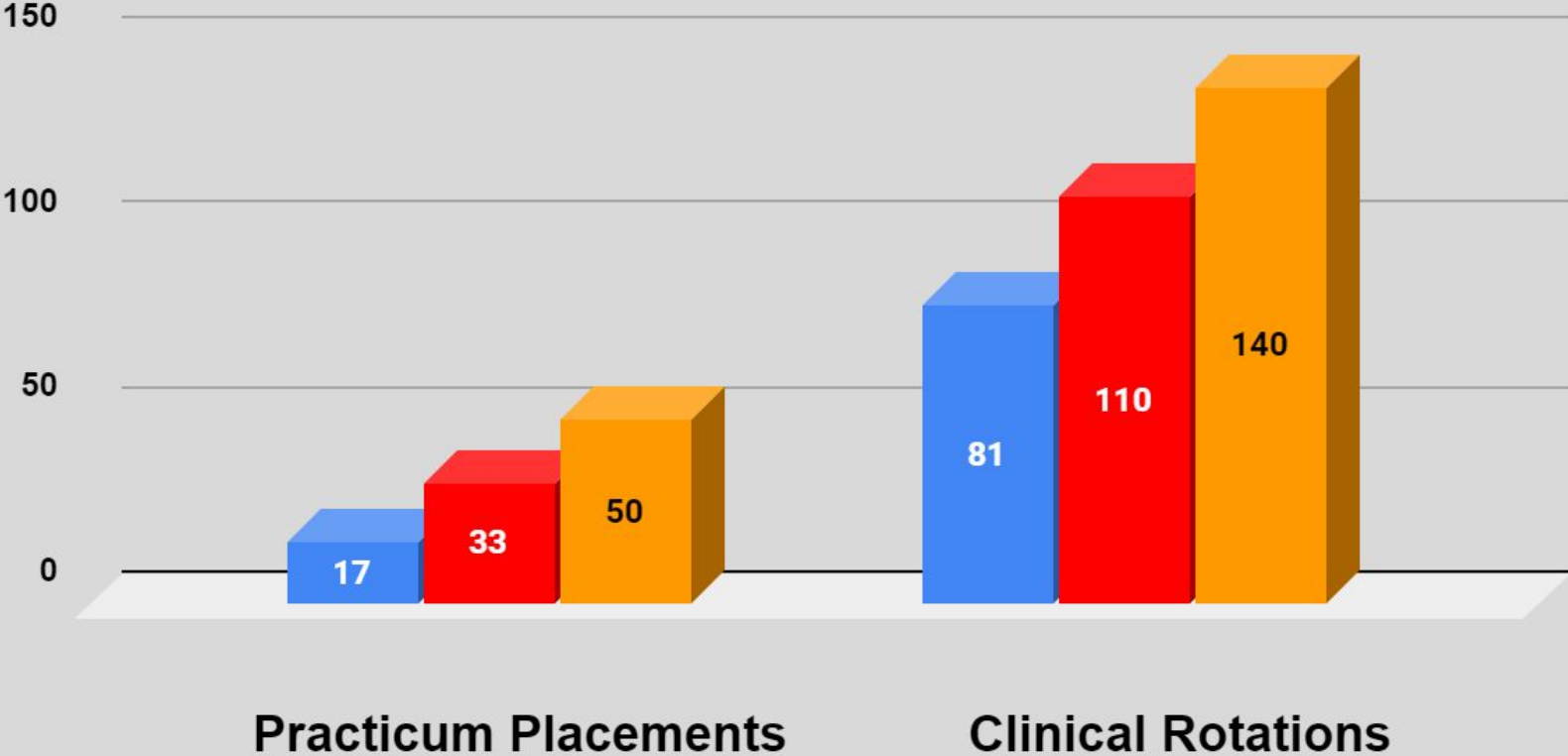
