Background Information

HB 1481 is a Texas bill that requires districts and charters to adopt a written policy prohibiting students from using a cellphone, tablet, smartwatch, or other personal communication device while on school property during the school day. The policy can prohibit students from bringing such a device onto school property or can provide for a method for the storage of the device while the student is on school property during the school day. It must include exceptions if needed for implementation of an IEP, by a student with a documented need as directed by a physician, or if needed to comply with a health or safety requirement.
