Testing

We are finally done testing 1 classroom 2 times a week. Per IDPH guidelines If you have 2 active cases in the same classroom or activity then we test everyone in that classroom or activity 2 times a week for a 2 week time period. A positive test then extends the testing period. While the testing is inconvenient, it is a better option than sending a classroom home for 10 days.

I also want to commend the Pana Hospital and the Christian County Health Department for their drive thru clinic. We have had a couple staff members test with them that were positive. They get their quarantine letter before they leave. This is a big help as we aren't chasing this paperwork.

SHIELD TEST
