The NAS department continues to curricularly align the program. We had our first meeting with JOM and our first Parent Advisory meeting. We will be working with JOM in any way that we can. We are also looking for Parent Advisory members. I have been given a few names of individuals that I am contacting. JOM and the parents that attended are very happy with the work being done for our students.

As for the language immersion program work continues to be done in providing an effective and efficient curriculum. The BPS Blackfeet Elder mentor program is still moving along although due to personal issues our mentors had to take a bit of time off.

In regards to the MBI/Olweus program all schools continues to work on implementing the programs. All of the teams continue to provide professional development at staff meetings. Our consultants were unable to conduct our Tiered Fidelity Inventory in December due to a family illness. Once this is conducted I will share the results with the board.

I feel that we are making progress in promoting the 4 anti-bully rules and definition of bullying. I am making observations of the buildings to observe if Class Meeting are occurring and if the four anti-bully rules are posted. At the middle school 8th grade advisory classes are sitting at 85% implementation of Class Meetings, Napi was at 99% and the High School was at 50%. Way to go Napi!
