Update <u>JGEA-AR</u>

Prior to placement in an alternative setting or tutoring (unless the result of Level 2 STAT or offense that requires expulsion by law) teams must have:

- Show evidence of Tiers of intervention:
 - Core classroom environment matches Standards of Practice.
 - If not, support teacher to implement
 - Evidence and results of Tier 2 intervention implemented with fidelity
 - Evidence of implementation of Behavior Support Plan, if ineffective then, and student is eligible for 504 or Individual Education Plan, then also
 - Evidence of implementation and results of full Functional Behavioral Assessment and Function Based Behavior Support Plan
 - Remember BSP defines adult behavior in supporting the student.
- The school team must show evidence of implementation across settings
- Results must show baseline, and maintenance, growth or decline
- Principals will review school-wide data by racial and special category monthly, as well as report what is being done to address areas of disproportionate discipline

If the above requirements are not met, and the school still wishes to refer a student to an alternative setting, the cost of such placement will come from the school's budget.
