

Community Education /Activities Director Report December 19, 2022 WEM Board of Education Meeting



• Winter Activities:

- o The winter sports activities have gotten off to a good start.
- O Basketball The girls are scheduled to play tomorrow night in Jackson (JCC) (w/ JH in Wells USC.) USC is not playing the conference schedule for Varsity this year. The girls are then scheduled to host St. James this Thursday. The Boys travel to Medford tonight, host USC tomorrow night (change from tomorrow night due to the lack of officials) and are scheduled to play at St. Clair Thursday before break. Both Boys and Girls JV and Varsity Teams will be playing in a "tournament" over break in Montgomery at TCU HS. Thursday Dec. 29 action begins at 5:30 PM and Friday December 30 starting at 9:30 am. After the break the Girls Basketball team gets started Tuesday January 3rd at Medford. The Boys get started Friday January 6th at Madelia.
