


**♦** FISD Teacher Turnover rate <u>decreased</u> 5.9% from 26% to 20.1%


#### Approaches Grade Level

### **Additional Areas of Strength:**

- Biology EOC Approaches Increased by 7%
- US History EOC Approaches Increased by 5%
