| Topic | Indicator/Description |
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| 1. Co-Curricular/Extra-Curricular Opportunities & Programs | The availability of activities outside of the classroom, including participation and alignment with student interests. |
| 2. Communication | The effectiveness of district and school communications, including channels, timing, and stakeholder engagement. |
| 3. Facilities | The condition and ability of school facilities to support student learning and activities. |
| 4. Finances | The allocation of district financial resources in supporting educational priorities and student needs. |
| 5. Programs & Courses | The options and quality of academic programs and courses offered, and alignment with student needs, interests, and future opportunities. |
| 6. Social Emotional Learning & Supports | The programs and practices used to support students' emotional well-being, social skills, mental health, and success. |
| 7. Special Education | The services and support offered for students with disabilities, including individualized education plans (IEPs), accommodations, resources, and specialized programs. |
| 8. Student Support Programs | The effectiveness of support programs for students needing extra help and academic intervention services (non-IEP). |
| 9. Technology | The use of educational technology tools and resources - including devices, software, and online platforms - in supporting student learning. |
| 10. Climate and Culture | Encouraging student growth in social and emotional development, cultural awareness, and global perspective. |
| 11. Other | |
