

Activities/Community Education Report for October 2025

With MEA in the rearview mirror, our fall extracurricular activities have wrapped up their regular seasons and have completed or are about to begin their section playoffs. The soccer team began their postseason before the break with an exciting home overtime victory against Hillcrest Academy followed by a tough loss in the semifinal round in the Red River Valley to East Grand Forks. Football will open their postseason on Tuesday evening at 6:00 PM and volleyball will begin section 5A tournament action on Wednesday at 7:00 PM with the opponent and location for each to be announced over the upcoming long weekend.

We are asking for the board's approval for two grant application resolutions with the MSHSL. Grant A is one we apply for annually with the funds going toward offsetting student activity fees. We are also applying for Grant B this year with the goal of being able to purchase several AED's to be placed at our outdoor facilities. Applications are due in mid-November with grants being awarded later in the winter.

Community Education is beginning to transition between seasons at this time. Driver's Education is happening now as there is a natural break between the school sports schedules. Our youth sports programs are turning their focus to winter activities including basketball and wrestling. Youth and adult classes will also have a seasonal theme from pumpkin art to holiday cookies.
