September 2014	Sample materials requested from publishers by Instructional Materials
October 2014	Instructional Materials Update during monthly Principals' Meeting. Presentation included Proclamation 2015 information including available online preview materials.
November 2014	Began receiving printed sample materials at Textbook Warehouse for distribution to campuses. Online digital samples available from each publisher as well as on ESC20 Preview website.
November 2014 to February 2015	Campus Instructional Officers distribute sample materials to all appropriate teachers and create textbook advisory committees. Advisory committee members review sample materials and conduct an analysis of curriculum TEKS objectives and activities for each textbook option. Recommendations are made to the IMA Committee.
January 9, 2015	IMA Committee Meeting to review district instructional materials selection criteria, SBOE Adopted Instructional Materials and EPISD eligible publisher list.
January 19, 2015	Instructional Officer Meeting with agenda item addressing selection procedures, sample materials and board policy requirements.
