- SUBJECT: DISCUSSION OF AND REQUEST FOR APPROVAL OF APPOINTMENT/REAPPOINTMENT OF SCHOOL HEALTH ADVISORY COUNCIL (SHAC) MEMBERS
- DATE: November 17, 2020

A Board shall establish a local School Health Advisory Council (SHAC) to assist a District in ensuring that local community values are reflected in the District's health education instruction. Much of the council must be parents of students enrolled in the District and who are not employed by the District. The Board may also appoint one (1) or more school teachers, public school administrators, district students, healthcare professionals, members of the business community, law enforcement representatives, senior citizens, clergy, representatives of non-profit health organizations, or representatives from other groups.

There are currently two (2) vacant SHAC Parent Member positions. The District has received four (4) Parent applications to fill the 2020-2021 SHAC Membership vacancies. The District has received an adequate number of applications to fill the 2020-2021 SHAC Membership vacancies. No further recruiting or advertising is necessary. **Board Members are encouraged to submit individuals for appointment consideration.** 

The Board of Trustees shall consider, but is not limited to, written applications that are submitted by any eligible person desiring to serve on the Council.

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Administrative Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Board of Trustees take action to appoint/reappoint applicants to serve as a School Health Advisory Council Member for a two (2) year term.
