TOPIC: Approval to Purchase i-Ready Instructional Licenses

RECOMMENDATION:

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District approve the purchase of the online adaptive instruction and assessment program, i-Ready Diagnostic Assessments for Math and Reading, from Curriculum Associates, for a total of \$302,221.00. This total includes free professional development, for a savings of \$55,635.00.

RATIONALE:

The purchase of i-Ready Diagnostic and Instruction will provide all kindergarten through sixth grade students with a State of Michigan approved assessment and instruction based on their personalized results. This will provide teachers with their students' strengths and weaknesses in reading and math. Additionally, students in grades seven, eight and nine will use the diagnostic portion of the program this year.

BUDGETARY INFORMATION:

The funding for this purchase will come from a mixture of Early Literacy Grant funds, 31A At-Risk state funds, and Academic Services Department funds.
