This Month at Franklin:

Throughout the month, our classes will discover ways to answer the unit's questions: What can we do in our community? What kinds of communities do people live in? What kinds of machines help farmers? Why do farmers have animals?

Pre-K's literacy skills will include a variety of engaging activities to help recognize upper and lowercase Tt, Aa, Ss, Ii, Vv, Yy, Pp, and Jj. They will be introduced to deleting a syllable from a word, segment onsets from rime units in words, and identify words that do and do not begin with the same sound.

As the month progresses, our students will be introduced to and work with numbers 5, 6, 7, and 8, and the colors orange, purple, black, and brown. The students will add up to 4 objects, begin subtracting 1 to 4 objects from a set, and identify position and location, and naming solid shapes. We are making mathematicians!
