# CCSD Superintendent Report March 2025

## **CCSD** Appreciations

- Maintenance Worker Appreciation Day was on Friday, March 7th. On behalf of CCSD, I would like to thank Mr. Daniel Nelson and Mr. Brent O'Connor for their hard work and dedication to our facilities. Their efforts keep our schools safe and running smoothly. We truly appreciate all they do for us!
- As CCSD's extra-curricular activities come to a close this year, I would like to extend my sincere gratitude to ALL CCSD Class Advisors and Coaches for the countless hours dedicated to supporting our students. Your commitment to advising, coaching, guiding, and mentoring helps shape our students' skills, character, and confidence. CCSD's school community is stronger because of you; hence, thank you for all you do!

# CCSD Finances/Budget

- CCSD has received the second and final payment of the FY 2025 one-time supplemental funding, totaling \$256,549. In total, CCSD received \$586,400 from this funding, which was approximately \$85,000 less than projected in the FY25 Board Approved Budget.
- As the Board may recall, CCSD's FY25 projected ADM was 677 students, but the current count stands at 631, a difference of 46 students. Given this, please remember to anticipate a reduction in CCSD's FY25 foundation and one-time supplemental funding.
- That said, now that the one-time supplemental funding has been provided by the state, CCSD has requested the remaining Required Local Contribution (RLC) balance from the City of Craig. As a reminder, the agreement between the CIty of Craig and CCSD was that the one-time, supplemental funding be deducted from the RLC. The RLC balance due from the City of Craig is \$542,698, please see below for details.

- In working on the preliminary FY 2026 General Operating Budget, I want to provide the Board with a heads up of CCSD's budget development and recommendations for next year.
- Due to declining enrollment, I am recommending a reduction of one teaching position in the elementary school next year. This adjustment will be made through attrition. Currently, we have a teacher employed under temporary SB 185 status, whose last day with CCSD is June 6, 2025. That position will not be refilled.

- Additionally, it is my recommendation to close our PACE Office in Ketchikan. Please note, no staff will be impacted by this closure. All employees will remain in their roles through June 30th, after which the office would officially close. CCSD will be committed to ensuring a smooth transition and will provide any necessary support during this process.
- CCSD is planning to hold a FY26 Budget Committee Meeting the week of March 31st. After that committee meeting, I would like to propose a CCSD School Board Work Session to discuss FY26 Budget Development in further detail the week of April 7th.
- As an FYI, Melinda and I have been working on submitting previously missing documents to the Department of Education & Early Development for the CEMS Rehabilitation Project. Progress is being made, and we recently received a check for \$2,689,962.60. This amount will be deposited into CCSD's Capital Projects Account, along with the previously issued \$778,533, bringing the total received to date to \$3,468,495.60, all designated for the CEMS Rehab Project.

#### Human Resources/Staff Updates

- Please make note that Ms. Tricia Stock requested and was granted reassignment to the Title I / District Testing Coordinator position and Ms. Grace Beckman to the Primary/Kindergarten position.
- CCSD currently has the following positions posted: PACE Statewide Homeschool Teacher, PACE Administrative Assistant (Part Time), High School English/Language Arts Teacher (\*Willingness to teach SS or Other Content Areas), K-12 Health/PE Teacher, 4th Grade Teacher, MS Mathematics Teacher.

## CCSD Curriculum/Instruction & Professional Development/PLC Committee Updates

- As the Board may recall, a CCSD Social Studies Curriculum Committee meeting was held after our last Regular School Board Meeting to review and discuss the state's recent adoption of Social Studies Standards.
- The committee collaboratively discussed the instructional shifts CCSD needs to consider given the adoption of these new standards. - I have submitted the reports required under Post-School Outcomes (Indicator 14) and Parent Involvement (Indicator 8) to the federal Office of Special Education Programs (OSEP) as part of Alaska's State Performance Plan/Annual Performance Report.

#### CEMS Rehabilitation Project

- After the Special Board Meeting on Wednesday, March 5, 2025, CCSD entered a construction contract with McG Constructors.
- On Friday, March 14, 2025, Mr. Daniel Nelson & I held a preconstruction meeting with Alaska Architects, McG Constructors, and MRV Architects to discuss the CEMS Rehabilitation Project.
- During the meeting, we focused on a few key topics, including the project schedule, the first day for access to the school site, staging, and substantial completion for the elementary school. These discussions have helped CCSD move forward with the project.
- McG Constructors plan on making a site visit to CCSD on Wednesday, April 3, 2025 to assess both the CES and CMS. This visit will help McG Constructors assess the project site and identify any area-specific needs for CCSD as we move forward with the next phases of the project.
