

SAFETY PROGRAM/RISK MANAGEMENT:  
ACCIDENT PREVENTION AND REPORTS

**EYE-PROTECTIVE DEVICES**

Eye-protective devices meeting the standards of the State Department of Health shall be worn by every teacher and student participating in shop or laboratory activities involving any of the following:

Hot molten metals

Milling, sawing, turning, shaping, cutting, or stamping of any solid materials

Heat treatment, tempering, or kiln firing of any metal or other materials

Gas or electric arc welding

Caustic or explosive materials

Caustic or explosive chemicals or hot liquids or solids

**PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)**

**Personal protective equipment (PPE) shall be worn according to the requirements of departments as noted in material safety data sheets (MSDS) required by manufacturers or according to the safety equipment needs prescribed by the department head. PPE shall include, but not limited to, eye-protective devices, protective footwear, hearing protection, respiratory protection, hand protection, lumbar support belts, and any other requirements.
