We are excited to inform you that the Laredo Economic Development Corporation (LEDC Mask Makers volunteers recently donated 1,100 Reusable Masks to United ISD's Students and Teachers from United South High and Middle Schools and to the CTE department.

With the COVID-19 Pandemic creating challenges that have impacted Laredo both economically and psychologically, the LEDC witnessed renewed interest in a nearly by-gone skill, sewing. The Laredo Mask Makers #We'veGotYouCovered, a non-profit grassroots initiative from the Laredo Economic Development Corporation, found volunteers to sew non-medical grade, reusable masks as recommended by the CDC for essential and COVID-vulnerable segments of our community. With the help of a \$2,000 grant from Electric Transmission Texas (ETT), an affiliate of AEP Texas, the LEDC was able to purchase materials necessary to begin the project and make donations to the Laredo community.

The LEDC has been making donations throughout Laredo and is including one of their member partners, UISD. The Mask Makers initiative donated 1,100 masks to United ISD. The organizers Olivia Varela, Yvette Medina, and Meva Saenz stated, "we hope this noble gesture greets United ISD's students and teachers with the same compassion in which each mask was made."
