ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT GRADUATION

Teen Leadership has been a graduation requirement for seniors at Coppell High School since 2001. The course Teen Leadership became a requirement for graduation when the "Freshmen Center" opened at CHS. While there has been much success from this course over the past eight years, the CHS administration recommends it become an elective effective with the incoming 2009-2010 freshmen class. This will result in more flexibility in scheduling the required increased math and science classes needed for graduation.

SUGGESTED CHANGES TO BOARD POLICY EIF HIGHLIGHTED IN RED

MINIMUM PROGRAM

The District requires completion of 2 credits in addition to those required by the state for graduation under the Minimum Program. The additional credits shall be electives. All students shall take Teen Leadership **until the fall of 2009. Beginning with the incoming 2009-2010 freshmen class, Teen Leadership will be an elective and will not be a requirement for graduation.**
