Re: CMS West Athletic Locker Replacement

As part of the 2013 bond project program, athletic lockers are to be replaced in the 7th and 8th grade girls' locker rooms and the 8th grade football locker room at Coppell Middle School West. The lockers that are being recommended to replace the existing lockers are the very durable DeBourgh brand "welded frame" lockers with lifetime guarantees. We have been utilizing this locker in all of our athletic locker replacements for the last several years.

The Interlocal Contract purchasing method as provided in the Texas Education Code 44.031 was used to obtain the proposal from A. Bargas and Associates, LLC. through the TASB BuyBoard. A. Bargas and Associates, LLC provided the proposal with the best value for the district at a total cost of \$50,852.00. This company has repeatedly provided the best cost for the most durable locker, as well as, excellent service in our two most recent locker replacements at CMS East and Coppell High School athletics, as well as, several other smaller projects. \$50,000.00 was originally estimated for this project. The excess \$852.00 will be paid out of bond contingency dollars.

RECOMMENDATION: That the Coppell ISD Board of Trustees approve A. Bargas and Associates, LLC as the contractor to complete the locker replacement project at the CMS West athletic locker rooms for the sum of \$50,852.00.
