Re: Instructional Materials Allotment Request

Proclamation 2015 calls for instructional materials for the following subject areas: Social Studies K-12, Mathematics 9-12 and Fine Arts K-12. The balance of the state provided IMA funds is \$878,521, which will not cover all areas provided for in Proclamation 2015. Therefore, Fine Arts resources will be considered next year. At this time, we request IMA funds from Proclamation 2015 in the amount of \$799,445 for Social Studies, Mathematics and the recurring costs for Language Arts to be expended. Included in this total are AP courses to update the instructional materials.

The state has authorized a deferred payment option to specified vendors for the purchase of resources this summer for the 2015-2016 school year to be paid with new IMA funds received after September 1, 2015. At this time we request \$236,053 for resources by the deferred payment option to complete the mathematics selection.

In total, we are requesting \$1,035,498 from IMA funds, \$799,445 from the current fund balance and \$236,053 from next year's funds through deferred billing.
