




KAUFMAN ISD - MAINTENANCE AND TRANSPORTATION REPORT

New awning assembled at the band lot. It will provide some shade during breaks at morning practice.





TRANSPORTATION



The Transportation Department received 90 requests for field trips this month using a total of 128 vehicles. 46 different drivers contributed to these extracurricular assignments. All went well !



KISD is currently hiring more drivers. Drivers are trained in house and the process takes around 6 weeks to complete. Chris Hodgdon is our trainer and he works with prospective drivers every day. Heather is our newest driver. Currently, there are 4 people in the training program. Our department is actively searching for more drivers.



The Transportation Department employs one lead mechanic and two assistant mechanics. These gentlemen do all of the maintenance on the complete fleet of buses, vans and additional vehicles. The total vehicle count is around 100 units. KISD is currently looking for additional mechanics and assistants to join the team.
