SUBJECT (item as it will appear on agenda): Incentivize Enrollment over 13 Credit Hours

RECOMMENDATION: Approve no charge for academic semester credit hours (SCH) above 13 credit hours

BACKGROUND/RATIONALE:

WCJC data indicates a large percentage of students enroll in four courses (12-13 SCH). To encourage students to enroll in an additional course, Executive Cabinet recommends students not be charged for academic semester credit hours exceeding 13 credit hours. The incentive supports student success to complete coursework on time. (Dual credit students and technical courses will be exempt.)
