Happy December!

In November we continued to work on skills for learning: focused attention, listening, following directions, being assertive, empathy and more. Additionally, we continued developing using our 'tools' (Breathing, Listening & Words - so far) to help in solving problems and staying in the green zone.

In December we will continue focusing on skills needed for learning.: Listening, focus, respect, empathy, positive self talk to name a few. Specifically we will review our 'Words Tool' one of the innate tools we have within ourselves to help us with emotional regulation, skills for learning, social responsibility and problem solving, "Using our words tool" reminds us to use our words in the right, way at the right time, for the right reason, to others AND yourself. Remembering to use our words in a way that will be helpful instead of hurtful is aids in the ability to problem solve with others when there is a conflict. It is also a great reminder to speak to ourselves (self talk) in a way that we would speak to a friend - with kindness and empathy.



Mindfulness (another way to describe it to younger kids - being where your feet are) will continue to be incorporated into our SEL lessons this year. Practicing mindfulness is a great way to train our brains to regain focus and calm. and be "present" in the moment (without judgment), whether it be in the classroom, at lunch, at recess or at home with family. I encourage you to practice this with your students at home. The more they practice, the more automatic a mindfulness response becomes. <u>MindYeti</u> is a great resource for PreK - 3rd grade. It was created by the Committee for Children who is the creator of Second Step, the SEL curriculum used at NES. <u>Waterford.org</u> is another great resource for kids and mindfulness as well.



Happy Holiday's NES families! If you are in need of youth care, please reach out to us. We pick up your students at Nehalem Elementary school at the end of each school day and are open until 5pm. Our cost is \$6 a day per child. This does include a nutritious snack and a host of enrichment activities (outdoor play/walks, gym time, crafts, music, science, etc.) If interested, please reach out to Angie or Kiley at NCRD by phone, email, website, or just stop in. We do have full day care when the school is closed if it is not a national holiday. Those days are \$20 per student. The no school day in December that we are providing care for are December 1, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22. Although there is no school the second week of the holiday break NCRD youth center will be closed.
